21-402. ADMINISTRATION OF SUBTITLE.

THE DIVISION OF VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SHALL ADMINISTER THIS SUBTITLE, AND MAY ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT IT.

21-403. INSPECTION AND LISTING OF SHELTERED WORKSHOPS.

(A) LISTING.

THE DIVISION OF VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION SHALL MAINTAIN A REGISTER OF PRIVATE NONPROFIT AGENCIES OR ORGANIZATIONS IT CONSIDERS QUALIFIED TO PROVIDE SHELTERED WORKSHOP EMPLOYMENT FOR DISABLED INDIVIDUALS.

(B) INSPECTION OF FACILITIES.

BEFORE IT REGISTERS ANY ORGANIZATION OR AGENCY, THE DIVISION OF VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION SHALL INSPECT THE SHELTERED WORKSHOP FACILITIES TO DETERMINE IF:

- (1) THEY ARE APPROPRIATE;
- (2) THE AGENCY OR ORGANIZATION IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE FUNDS UNDER THIS SUBTITLE; AND
- (3) THE FACILITIES MEET THE STANDARDS FOR SHELTERED WORKSHOPS ACCEPTED BY THE REHABILITATION SERVICES ADMINISTRATION OF THE FEDERAL DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, EDUCATION, AND WELFARE.

21-404. SHELTERED EMPLOYMENT.

(A) IN GENERAL.

THE DIVISION OF VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION MAY CONTRACT WITH ANY APPROVED AGENCY OR ORGANIZATION TO PROVIDE EXTENDED SHELTERED EMPLOYMENT TO ANY DISABLED INDIVIDUAL IF THE DIVISION IS SATISFIED THAT HE:

- (1) IS AT LEAST 17 YEARS OLD;
- (2) CANNOT FIND EMPLOYMENT IN THE OPEN LABOR MARKET; AND
 - (3) MAY BE EXPECTED TO BENEFIT FROM SHELTERED
