

(IV) THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS FROM A COUNTY WHERE A CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION OF THE DIVISION OF CORRECTION IS LOCATED, WHO SHALL BE SELECTED BY THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT.

(C) COMPENSATION.

EACH MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL:

(1) SERVES WITHOUT COMPENSATION; AND

(2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS.

(D) CHAIRMAN, MEETINGS, AND STAFF.

(1) THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL SERVE AS CHAIRMAN OF THE COUNCIL.

(2) THE COUNCIL SHALL DESIGNATE THE TIME AND PLACE OF ITS MEETINGS AND MAY ADOPT RULES FOR THE CONDUCT OF ITS MEETINGS.

(3) THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SHALL PROVIDE TECHNICAL AND CLERICAL ASSISTANCE AND SUPPORT TO THE COUNCIL.

22-102. DUTIES OF COUNCIL.

(A) PROGRAM FOR INSTITUTIONS.

THE EDUCATION COORDINATING COUNCIL FOR CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS SHALL DEVELOP AND RECOMMEND AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM FOR EACH CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION IN THE DIVISION OF CORRECTION. THE PROGRAMS SHALL MEET THE SPECIAL NEEDS AND CIRCUMSTANCES OF THE INMATES IN THE INSTITUTION.

(B) REPORT TO GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

THE COUNCIL SHALL REPORT ITS ACTIVITIES TO THE GOVERNOR AND THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY BEFORE JULY 1 OF EACH YEAR.
