

SERVICES SHALL APPOINT A DIRECTOR OF EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES.

(B) COMPENSATION.

THE DIRECTOR SHALL RECEIVE THE SALARY PROVIDED IN THE BUDGET OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES.

(C) DUTIES.

THE DIRECTOR SHALL:

(1) IMPLEMENT AND OPERATE THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS, DEVELOPED BY THE COUNCIL, IN THE CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS;

(2) MEET WITH AND ADVISE THE COUNCIL ABOUT THESE PROGRAMS; AND

(3) CONSULT WITH THE COMMISSIONER OF CORRECTION AND THE WARDEN OF EACH INSTITUTION ABOUT THE OPERATION OF THESE PROGRAMS.

22-104. FUNDING.

(A) IN GENERAL.

FUNDS FOR THE OPERATION OF THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS IN CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS SHALL BE PROVIDED IN THE BUDGET OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

(B) OTHER AGENCIES MAY CONTRIBUTE.

THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES AND OTHER STATE AGENCIES MAY CONTRIBUTE TO THESE PROGRAMS.

(C) USE OF FUNDS.

FUNDS APPROPRIATED FOR EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS IN CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS MAY NOT BE DIVERTED, BY BUDGET AMENDMENT OR OTHERWISE, TO ANY OTHER PURPOSE.
