

The present power of the Board to adopt rules and regulations governing the use of the library is deleted as unnecessary in light of the similar provision in subsection (c) of this section.

The only other changes are in style.

(C) MANAGEMENT OF LIBRARY.

EACH BOARD OF LIBRARY TRUSTEES MAY:

- (1) ESTABLISH AND OPERATE LIBRARIES AT ANY LOCATION IN THE COUNTY;
- (2) DETERMINE THE POLICY OF THE LIBRARY; AND
- (3) ADOPT REASONABLE RULES, REGULATIONS, AND BYLAWS FOR THE USE OF THE LIBRARY AND THE CONDUCT OF ITS BUSINESS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection presently appears as Art. 77, §173(a) (1), (2), (3), and (6).

The reference to the power of the Board to "choose its own officers" now appears in §23-304 of this subtitle.

The only other changes are in style.

(D) FISCAL MATTERS.

EACH BOARD OF LIBRARY TRUSTEES MAY:

- (1) ADVISE IN THE PREPARATION OF, AND APPROVE, THE LIBRARY BUDGET;
- (2) RECEIVE, ACCOUNT FOR, CONTROL, AND SUPERVISE, UNDER THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COUNTY GOVERNING BODY, THE SPENDING OF ALL PUBLIC FUNDS RECEIVED BY THE LIBRARY; AND
- (3) USE THE SERVICES OF THE FISCAL AGENCIES OF THE COUNTY GOVERNING BODY.

(E) AUDIT AND ANNUAL REPORT.

EACH BOARD OF LIBRARY TRUSTEES SHALL:

- (1) PROVIDE FOR AN AUDIT AT LEAST ANNUALLY, BY AN ACCOUNTANT APPROVED BY THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF ITS BUSINESS AND FINANCIAL TRANSACTIONS AND OF THE ACCOUNTS OF ITS TREASURER;
