- (II) ART, MUSIC, OR DRAMA:
- (III) RADIO AND TELEVISION;
- (IV) LIBRARIES: AND
- (V) ANY OTHER FIELD THAT THE GOVERNOR CONSIDERS APPROPRIATE FOR THE COMMISSION.
- (3) THE COMMISSION SHALL INCLUDE TWO MEMBERS NOMINATED BY THE STATE EOARD OF EDUCATION.
- (4) THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS SHALL SERVE EX OFFICIO.
 - (C) TERM AND VACANCIES.
- (1) EACH APPOINTED MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION SERVES FOR A TERM OF 5 YEARS AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES. THESE TERMS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS SERVING ON THE COMMISSION AS OF JULY 1, 1978.
- (2) A MEMBER APPOINTED TO FILL A VACANCY IN AN UNEXPIRED TERM SERVES ONLY FOR THE REMAINDER OF THAT TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
 - (3) A MEMBER MAY BE REAPPOINTED.
 - (D) COMPENSATION.

EACH MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION:

- (1) SERVES WITHOUT COMPENSATION; AND
- (2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from Art. 77, §161(b) except the second sentence of (1).

The present reference to the terms of the initial appointees is deleted as obsolete.

The terms of the members serving on July 1, 1978 expire as follows: two in 1979, four in 1980, three in 1981, and two in 1982.
