

THE BOARD SHALL DETERMINE THE TIME AND PLACE OF ITS MEETINGS AND MAY ADOPT RULES FOR THE CONDUCT OF ITS MEETINGS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsection (a) of this section presently appears as the second sentence of Art. 77, §161(b) (1).

Subsection (b) of this section is new language added to conform to similar provisions elsewhere in this article.

24-204. BUDGET AND STAFF.

(A) BUDGET.

(1) THE COMMISSION AND THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION ANNUALLY SHALL EACH PREPARE A BUDGET REQUEST TO PROVIDE FUNDS TO PERFORM THEIR DUTIES UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

(2) THE COMMISSION MAY RECEIVE AND SPEND ANY GRANT OR GIFT BUDGETED OR PROVIDED FOR IT.

(B) STAFF.

(1) THE COMMISSION SHALL HAVE THE STAFF PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(2) THE SECRETARIAL, STENOGRAPHIC, CLERICAL, AND CUSTODIAL EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMISSION ARE MEMBERS OF THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE UNDER ARTICLE 64A OF THE CODE.

(3) ALL OTHER EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMISSION ARE IN THE STATE SERVICE BUT NOT IN THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

24-205. RESPONSIBILITY FOR BROADCASTING.

(A) IN GENERAL.

THE COMMISSION SHALL OPERATE A SYSTEM OF STATE, REGIONAL, AND LOCAL FACILITIES TO PROVIDE EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL RADIO AND TELEVISION PROGRAMS IN THIS STATE.

(B) RESPONSIBILITY FOR PROGRAMS USED IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION:

(1) IS RESPONSIBLE FOR AND SHALL CONTROL THE PREPARATION, CONTENT, AND PROGRAMMING OF ALL EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION AND RADIO PROGRAMS USED IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND
