C. SEAL.

THE COMMISSION SHALL HAVE A SEAL.

D. OFFICERS.

THE COMMISSION SHALL ELECT ANNUALLY, FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS, A CHAIRMAN, WHO SHALL BE A GOVERNOR, A VICE—CHAIRMAN AND A TREASURER. THE COMMISSION SHALL PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF AN EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR. SUCH EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL SERVE AT THE PLEASURE OF THE COMMISSION, AND TOGETHER WITH THE TREASURER AND SUCH OTHER PERSONNEL AS THE COMMISSION MAY DEEM APPROPRIATE SHALL BE BONDED IN SUCH AMOUNT AS THE COMMISSION SHALL DETERMINE. THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL BE SECRETARY.

E. APPOINTMENT, REMOVAL, DISCHARGE, DUTIES AND COMPENSATION OF PERSONNEL: PERSONNEL POLICIES.

IRRESPECTIVE OF THE CIVIL SERVICE, PERSONNEL OR OTHER MERIT SYSTEM LAWS OF ANY OF THE PARTY STATES, THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE STEERING COMMITTEE SHALL APPOINT, REMOVE OR DISCHARGE SUCH PERSONNEL AS MAY BE NECESSARY FOR THE PERFORMANCE OF THE FUNCTIONS OF THE COMMISSION, AND SHALL FIX THE DUTIES AND COMPENSATION OF SUCH PERSONNEL. THE COMMISSION IN ITS BYLAWS SHALL PROVIDE FOR THE PERSONNEL POLICIES AND PROGRAMS OF THE COMMISSION.

F. SOURCES FOR PERSONNEL.

THE COMMISSION MAY BORROW, ACCEPT OR CONTRACT FOR THE SERVICE OF PERSONNEL FROM ANY PARTY JURISDICTION, THE UNITED STATES, OR ANY SUBDIVISION OR AGENCY OF THE AFOREMENTIONED GOVERNMENTS, OR FROM ANY AGENCY OF TWO OR MORE OF THE PARTY JURISDICTIONS OR THEIR SUBDIVISIONS.

G. DCNATIONS AND GRANTS.

THE COMMISSION MAY ACCEPT FOR ANY OF ITS PURPOSES AND FUNCTIONS UNDER THIS COMPACT ANY AND ALL DONATIONS, AND GRANTS OF MONEY, EQUIPMENT, SUPPLIES, MATERIALS AND SERVICES, CONDITIONAL OR OTHERWISE, FROM ANY STATE, THE UNITED STATES, OR ANY OTHER GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY, OR FROM ANY PERSON, FIRM, ASSOCIATION, FOUNDATION, OR CORPORATION, AND MAY RECEIVE, UTILIZE AND DISPOSE OF THE SAME. ANY DONATION OR GRANT ACCEPTED BY THE COMMISSION PURSUANT TO THIS PARAGRAPH OR SERVICES BERROWED PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH (P) OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE REPORTED IN THE ANNUAL REPORT OF THE COMMISSION. SUCH REPORT SHALL INCLUDE THE NATURE, AMOUNT AND CONDITIONS, IF ANY, OF THE DONATION, GRANT, OR SERVICES BORROWED, AND THE IDENTITY OF THE DONOR OR LENDER.

H. FACILITIES; REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY.

THE COMMISSION MAY ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN SUCH PACILITIES AS MAY BE NECESSARY FOR THE TRANSACTING OF ITS BUSINESS. THE COMMISSION MAY ACQUIRE, HOLD, AND CONVEY REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY AND ANY INTEREST THEREIN.
