2-106. GENERAL AUTHORITY OF DEPARTMENT.

THE DEPARTMENT HAS AUTHORITY OVER:

- (1) MATTERS OF ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION THAT AFFECT THIS STATE; AND
- (2) THE GENERAL CARE AND SUPERVISION OF PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION.

SUBTITLE 2. STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

2-201. STATE BOARD ESTABLISHED.

THERE IS A STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION IN THE DEPARTMENT.

It is set forth as a separate section for emphasis.

See also §2-102 of this title, which provides that the State Board is the "head of the Department".

The remainder of Art. 41, §200 is deleted as obsolete and duplicative of §2-102(a) of this subtitle.

2-202. MEMBERSHIP.

(A) COMPOSITION.

THE STATE BOARD CONSISTS OF NINE MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.

- (B) OUALIFICATIONS.
- (1) IN MAKING APPOINTMENTS TO THE STATE BOARD, THE GOVERNOR SHALL CONSIDER REPRESENTATION FROM:
 - (I) ALL PARTS OF THIS STATE: AND
- (II) AREAS OF THIS STATE WITH CONCENTRATIONS OF POPULATION OR UNIQUE NEEDS.
- (2) THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD SHALL BE APPOINTED FROM THE GENERAL PUBLIC.
