~~Any political party with which ten per centum or more of the registered voters of this State are affiliated, as shown by the most recent statement of registration of the State Administrative Board of Election Laws compiled pursuant to § 3-9A (b) of this article shall nominate (1) all its candidates for public office; and (2) all members of the State and local central committees in said political party at the succeeding primary election conducted under the provisions of this subtitle; and shall elect the appropriate number of delegates to a national convention as provided in this article. CANDIDATES FOR A COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL BE NOMINATED AT A PRIMARY ELECTION WHEN SO PROVIDED IN THE EDUCATION ARTICLE. The several boards shall not print on the official ballot to be voted at any general or special election to be hereafter held the name or names of any such candidate or candidates for election in Baltimore City or any of the counties of the State of any of said parties who shall not be so nominated and whose nomination shall not be certified to them or to the State Administrative Board of Election Laws as having been so nominated.~~
