8-1- Required; how attested.

- (B) A CERTIFICATE OF NOMINATION FOR CANDIDATES FOR A COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL BE ISSUED AS PROVIDED IN §4-2-OF THIS ARTICLE.
- (C) [(b)] The certificate of nomination of any person nominated by petition shall contain the name of the person so nominated, the address of his residence, the nature of his business and the name of the office to which he has been nominated.

9-1- Nomination declined.

(a) Primary election. (1) Whenever any person who has-filed-a certificate of candidacy for nomination-in-any primary election shall, in a writing signed by him, and acknowledged before a notary public, notify the officer or board with whom the certificate of candidacy is required to be filed-by-this-articley-within-18-days-after-the-final filing-date established-in-§ 4A-3 of this -article that he desires to withdraw as a candidate for such nomination, the certificate of candidacy shall thereupon be and become void; and the name of any person so withdrawing shall not be printed upon the ballots to be used-at the primary election. IN CHARLES AND PRINCE GIORGE'S COUNTIES, A CANDIDATE FOR THE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION MAY FILE A CERTIFICATE OF WITHDRAWAL-ON OR BEFORE-45 DAYS BEFORE THE PRIMARY ELECTION. IN HOWARD AND KENT COUNTIES, A CANDIDATE FOR THE COUNTY BOARD -- OF BDUCATION MAY FILE A CERTIFICATE OF WITHDRAWAL ON OR BEFORE 65 DAYS BIFORE THE PRIMARY ELECTION. IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY A CANDIDATE FOR THE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION MAY FILE A CERTIFICATE OF WITHDRAWAL WITHIN 7 DAYS AFTER THE DEADLINE FOR FILING A -- CERTIFICATE -- OF -- CANDIDACY -THIS - SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO CANDIDATES FOR THE COUNTY BOARD-OF-EDUCATION-IN-CARROLL-AND-WASHINGTON-COUNTIES. filing of a valid certificate of withdrawal-of-candidacy is a-final-act-of withdrawal; and a-person-who-files-such-a sertificate of withdrawal may not reinstate his candidacy, unless-the-time-limit-for-the-filing-of candidacies has not expired. -- No -filing -fees-shall-be-refunded to-persons who withdraw in accordance with this section, subject, however, to-§-4A-7 of-this article.
