~~In primary elections, before a voter is admitted to the voting machine, it shall be adjusted by the judge in charge thereof, so that such voter shall only be able to vote for the candidates or offices of that party with which he is affiliated, PROVIDED THAT, EACH VOTER, WITH OR WITHOUT PARTY AFFILIATION, SHALL BE PERMITTED TO VOTE IN A PRIMARY ELECTION FOR A COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION WHERE THE ELECTION IS HELD.~~
