

(B) ENFORCEMENT OF EDUCATION ARTICLE.

(1) THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL ENFORCE THE PROVISIONS OF:

(I) THIS ARTICLE THAT ARE WITHIN HIS JURISDICTION; AND

(II) THE BYLAWS, RULES, AND REGULATIONS OF THE STATE BOARD.

(2) IF AN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION OR COUNTY BOARD VIOLATES ANY OF THESE PROVISIONS, THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT, BY WRITTEN NOTICE, MAY REQUIRE THE STATE COMPTROLLER TO WITHHOLD FROM THAT INSTITUTION OR BOARD:

(I) ALL OR ANY PART OF AN APPROPRIATION MADE BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY; AND

(II) ALL OR ANY PART OF ANY OTHER PAYMENT FROM FUNDS BUDGETED BY THE STATE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from Art. 77, §24.

In subsection (b) (1) (ii) of this section, the words "rules and regulations" are added as this is the apparent statutory intent and as the State Superintendent apparently has this authority under subsection (b) (1) (i) of this section.

The only other changes are in style.

(C) CARRYING OUT EDUCATIONAL POLICIES; CONFERENCES; PAMPHLETS.

THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL:

(1) CARRY OUT THE EDUCATIONAL POLICIES OF THE STATE BOARD;

(2) CALL AND CONDUCT CONFERENCES OF COUNTY BOARDS AND PROFESSIONAL PERSONNEL OF THE COUNTY SCHOOL SYSTEMS ON THE CONDITION, NEEDS, AND IMPROVEMENT OF THE SCHOOLS; AND

(3) PREPARE AND PUBLISH PAMPHLETS TO:

(I) STIMULATE PUBLIC INTEREST;

(II) PROMOTE THE WORK OF EDUCATION; AND

(III) FOSTER PROFESSIONAL INSIGHT AND EFFICIENCY IN TEACHERS.
