Provided that no part of this
General Fund appropriation
may be paid to any physician
or surgeon or any hospital,
clinic or other medical
facility for or in connec-
tion with the performance of
any abortion, except upon
certification by a physician
or surgeon, based upon his
or her professional judg-
ment, that the procedure is
necessary, provided one of
the following conditions
exists:

1. Where continuation of the
pregnancy is likely to
result in the death of the
woman; or
2. Where there is a risk
that continuation of the
pregnancy would have a
detrimental effect on the
health of the woman; or
3. Where there is a risk of
the birth of the child
with permanent physical
deformity, genetic defect
or mental retardation; or
4. Where medical procedures
are necessary for a victim
of rape, sexual offense or
incest, when the rape,
sexual offense or incest
has been reported to a law
enforcement agency or to a
public or private health
or social agency.
