WHEN A BOARD IS REQUIRED BY LAW TO TRANSFER DOCUMENTS TO THE HALL OF RECORDS, THE BOARD SHALL MAKE AND KEEP A RECORD INDICATING THE NATURE OF THE DOCUMENTS AND IDENTIFYING THE DOCUMENTS FOR RETRIEVAL PURPOSES. A COPY OF THIS RECORD SHALL BE FILED WITH THE STATE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF ELECTION LAWS.
