## CHAPTER 320

(House Bill 256)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Proof of Age and Identity Requirements

FOR the purpose of providing uniform proof of age and identity requirements for the issuance by the Motor Vehicle Administration of Special-Identification-Cards and Age of Majority Cards.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Transportation Section 12-301(a)-and 12-302(a) Annotated Code of Maryland (1977 Volume and 1978 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Transportation

12-301-

- (a) On--{request}--APPLICATION,--the---Administration shall--issue-a-special-identification-card-to-any-individual who:
  - (1) Is-a-resident-of-this-State;-fand
  - (2) Does-not-have-a-driver's-license;-AND
- (3) PRESENTS-A-BIRTH-CERTIFICATE-OR-OTHER-PROOF OF--AGE-AND-IDENTITY---THAT--IS---SATISFACTORY---TO---THE ADMINISTRATION:

- (a) On Application, the Administration shall issue an age of majority identification card to any adult who:
  - (1) Is a resident of this State; and
- (2) On Application to the Administration, presents [:
  - (i) A birth certificate as proof of age;
