

FOR the purpose of redefining for purposes of regulation of public water systems, "person" to include State and federal entities, certain special tax districts, and employees, officers and agents of certain persons.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 43 - Health  
Section 386A(g)  
Annotated Code of Maryland  
(1971 Replacement Volume and 1978 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 43 - Health

386A.

In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated:

(g) "Person" means an individual, corporation, company, association, partnership, STATE, county, municipal corporation, the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission, FEDERAL AGENCY, or any special taxing area OR DISTRICT that operates a public water system AND INCLUDES AN OFFICER, EMPLOYEE, OR AGENT OF ANY OF THEM.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.

(House Bill 357)

AN ACT concerning

Weights and Measures Law - Solid Fuel

FOR the purpose of deleting from the Agriculture Article, the provisions for general supervision by the Secretary of Agriculture of persons weighing solid fuels and issuing delivery tickets.
