award shall not exceed [five hundred dollars] \$1,000, (2) the amount of [such] THE emergency award shall be deducted from any final award made to the claimant, and (3) the excess of the amount of [such] THE emergency award over the final award, or the full amount of the emergency award if [not] NO final award is made, shall be repaid by the claimant to the Board.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.
