

Baltimore City - Deputy Sheriff

FOR the purpose of permitting any Baltimore City deputy sheriff, during the course of his employment, to ride in Baltimore City on certain public transportation without paying any fare upon showing his identification.

BY adding to

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings
Section 2-309(d)~~(2)~~ (3)
Annotated Code of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

2-309.

(D) ~~(2)~~ (3) DURING THE COURSE OF HIS EMPLOYMENT, ANY DEPUTY SHERIFF OF BALTIMORE CITY MAY RIDE IN BALTIMORE CITY ON PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION OF THE MASS TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION WITHOUT PAYING ANY FARE IF HE SHOWS PROPER IDENTIFICATION REGARDING HIS POSITION AS A DEPUTY SHERIFF.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.
