SERVICES covered under the Maryland medical assistance pharmacy program up to the amount paid for the same services under the medical assistance PHARMACY program subject to a copayment not to exceed \$1 [per prescription] FOR EACH COVERED SERVICE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.

CHAPTER 367

(House Bill 1050)

AN ACT concerning

Highway User Revenues - Allocations to Municipalities

FOR the purpose of altering increasing the municipal share of highway user revenues; -and-phasing-in-the-increase in-a-certain-period-of-time.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Transportation Section 8-405(b) Annotated Code of Maryland (1977 Volume and 1978 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Transportation

8-405.

- (b) During the fiscal year beginning after a request is made, the Administration shall allocate to the municipality, from the gross share of highway user revenues allocated under § 8-404 of this subtitle to the county within which the municipality is located, its net share of highway user revenues, to be determined by adding:
- (1) The amount that results from applying to one half of the available revenues the ratio that, as of December 1 of the preceding calendar year, the total mileage of county roads in the municipality bears to the total mileage of county roads in the county; and
- (2) [62 1/2 percent of the] THE amount that results from applying to one half of the available revenues
