

(b) (1) A person may possess any green pelt of any fur-bearing mammal until March 25 for purposes of curing the skins. However, in Frederick, Garrett, Allegany, Carroll, Howard, and Washington counties, a person may hunt or trap mink or muskrat between November 15 and February 15, of the year following, and a person may possess any green mink and muskrat pelt until February 25 for purposes of curing the skin. IN THE REMAINDER OF THE STATE, A PERSON MAY HUNT OR TRAP MINK OR MUSKRAT BETWEEN DECEMBER 15 AND MARCH 15 OF THE YEAR FOLLOWING.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.

CHAPTER 373

(House Bill 1127)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore County - Alcoholic Beverages
(Sale of Wine at Wineries)

FOR the purpose of permitting wineries with either a Class 3 or Class 4 manufacturer's license in Baltimore County to obtain a Class A light wine license; authorizing the holder to sell light wines produced at the winery in any quantity under certain conditions; and clarifying language.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

(a) A Class A light wine license may be issued by the clerk of the circuit court of the county in which the place of business is located to any holder of a Class 4 manufacturer's license. IN BALTIMORE COUNTY A CLASS A LIGHT
