- (b) If permitted by the board of trustees of a community college, any resident of this State who is 60 years old or older OR WHO IS RETIRED AND DISABLED AS DEFINED BY THE SOCIAL SECURITY OR RAILROAD RETIREMENT ACT AND who enrolls in any class at the community college that has at least ten or is being continued with less than ten regularly enrolled students:
  - (1) Is exempt from payment of tuition; and
- (2) Shall be counted in computing full-time equivalent enrollment under § 16-403 of this Title.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.

## CHAPTER 379

(House Bill 1281)

AN ACT concerning

Inspections of Hospitals and Related Institutions

FOR the purpose of making it a misdemeanor for certain persons to give ex--xeceive information about an anticipated inspection of a hospital or related institution in certain circumstances; and providing a penalty.
