(d) Any funds PREVIOUSLY OR SUBSEQUENTLY APPROPRIATED OR REIMBURSED TO THE DEPARTMENT FROM THE LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND OF the United States Department of Interior[, Bureau of Outdoor Recreation, allocates to the State from the Land and Water Conservation Fund may] SHALL be used [either for] TO SUPPLEMENT THE acquisition [or] AND development [projects] PROGRAM OF THE DEPARTMENT AND OF OTHER ELIGIBLE STATE AGENCIES AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT BODIES. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SUBMIT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AN ANNUAL REPORT OF RECEIPTS AND DISBURSEMENTS OF THESE FUNDS.
