CHAPTER 389

(House Bill 1411)

AN ACT concerning

Maryland Historical Trust - Bicentennial Observations

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Maryland Historical Trust and the Maryland Hall of Records Commission to plan, conduct and coordinate, with appropriate ceremonies and activities, the observance of certain bicentennial anniversaries in Maryland; providing for the transfer of certain funds; and establishing a joint committee to carry out the provisions of this Act.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 41 - Governor - Executive and Administrative Departments

181E.

(a) The trustees shall have the following powers and duties:

(M) TO PLAN, CONDUCT, AND COORDINATE, WITH THE MARYLAND HALL OF RECORDS COMMISSION, APPROPRIATE CEREMONIES AND ACTIVITIES, FOR THE OBSERVANCE IN MARYLAND OF THE BICENTENNIAL ANNIVERSARIES OF:
