(c) (2) [In] UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 1979, IN the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries, a person may not set or fish any gill net whose size of stretched mesh, allowing a 1/4 inch variable, is more than 7 inches. AFTER DECEMBER 13, 1979, IN THE CHESAPEAKE BAY AND ITS TRIBUTARIES, A PERSON MAY NOT SET OR FISH ANY GILL NET WHOSE SIZE OF STRETCHED MESH IS MORE THAN 6 INCHES.

- (c) (2) A person may not set or fish with any gill net within 1,200 feet of any pier that supports either span of the William Preston Lane, Jr. Memorial Bridge between [June 1] MAY 1 and [September 30] OCTOBER 31, inclusive.
