

(2) THE DEPARTMENT OF FISCAL SERVICES SHALL PREPARE AN ESTIMATE OF THE PRESENT COST OF LAUNDRY SERVICES AT THE HOSPITAL. THE ESTIMATE SHALL INCLUDE THE COST OF TRANSPORTATION, BUT IT MAY NOT INCLUDE THE COST OF THE DRIVER.

(3) UPON THE COMPLETION OF THE COST ESTIMATE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF FISCAL SERVICES, THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE HOSPITAL SHALL ADVERTISE FOR AND ACCEPT COMPETITIVE BIDS FOR A CONTRACT TO PROVIDE LAUNDRY SERVICES AT THE HOSPITAL.

(4) IF ANY OF THE BIDS ARE BELOW THE AMOUNT OF THE COST ESTIMATE, THE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL CONTRACT WITH THE LOW BIDDER FOR THE PROVISION OF LAUNDRY SERVICES. THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE HOSPITAL MAY REJECT A BID IF, IN HIS JUDGMENT, THE BIDDER CAN NOT SATISFACTORILY FULFILL THE TERMS OF THE CONTRACT.

(5) IF THERE ARE NO BIDS LOWER THAN THE COST ESTIMATE, THE PRESENT ARRANGEMENTS OF LAUNDRY SERVICE AT THE HOSPITAL SHALL CONTINUE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.

CHAPTER 410

(House Bill 1735)

AN ACT concerning

Frederick County - Alcoholic Beverages
(License Quotas)

FOR the purpose of providing that in Frederick County there may not be issued more than one certain class license for each unit of 2,000 people, as determined by a certain standard.
