SECTION--2---AND--BE-IT-FURTHER-ENACTED,-That-this-Act shall-take-effect-July-1,-1979.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety and having been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 416

(House Bill 1801)

AN ACT concerning

Historical Watercraft License Identification Plaque

FOR the purpose of providing for a historical watercraft lieense identification plaque for boats of a certain age and in a certain condition, to be issued by the Department of Natural Resources; providing for a certain fee for the lieense identification plaque; providing for the Department of Natural Resources to issue a special lieense-plate identification plaque to be displayed on the historical watercraft; and generally relating to the lieensing identifying of historical watercraft.

BY adding to

Article - Natural Resources Section 8-737 Annotated Code of Maryland (1974 Volume and 1978 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

8-737.

- (A) A PERSON MAY OBTAIN A HISTORICAL WATERCRAFT **LIGENSE** IDENTIFICATION PLAQUE FROM THE DEPARTMENT FOR A BOAT THAT IS:
  - (1) 25 YEARS OLD OR OLDER; AND
