- (2) CONSTRUCTED-OF-WOOD; -AND
- (3) POWERED BY THE BOAT'S ORIGINAL TYPE OF POWER PLANT.
- (B) THE FEE FOR A HISTORICAL WATERCRAFT LICENSE IDENTIFICATION PLAQUE IS \$25. THE LICENSE IDENTIFICATION PLAQUE SHALL BE VALID FOR THE LIFE OF THE BOAT.
- (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE A HISTORICAL WATERCRAFT bigense-plate identification plaque, of its own design, to a person who applies to the department on a form it supplies. When prominently displayed on the boat, a historical watercraft bigense identification plaque shall entitle the boat owner to apply to participate in parades, shows, and special displays. The historical watercraft bigense identification plaque may not qualify a boat for general recreational use.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.

CHAPTER 417

(House Bill 1803)

AN ACT concerning
