- (A) FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION "PUBLIC RECORD" INCLUDES ALL OFFICIAL BOOKS, PAPERS, OR RECORDS WHETHER KEPT ON A MANUAL OR AUTOMATED BASIS, WHICH ARE CREATED, RECEIVED, OR USED BY THE STATE OR ANY AGENCY THEREOF, A BICOUNTY OR A MULTICOUNTY AGENCY, ANY COUNTY, MUNICIPALITY, OR OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISION.
- (B) IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR A PERSON TO DO OR ATTEMPT TO DO THE FOLLOWING:
- (1) WILFULLY MAKE A FALSE ENTRY IN ANY PUBLIC RECORDS: OR
- (2) EXCEPT UNDER PROPER AUTHORITY, WILFULLY DUPLICATE, ALTER, DEFACE, DESTROY, REMOVE, OR CONCEAL ANY PUBLIC RECORD.
- (C) ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND MAY BE IMPRISONED UP TO 3 YEARS OR FINED UP TO \$1,000, OR BOTH.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.
