application. The Department of Health AND MENTAL HYGIENE shall not issue a permit for a landfill OR SLUDGE COMPOSTING FACILITY unless it has complied with all county zoning and land use requirements of the county in which the proposed landfill OR SLUDGE COMPOSTING FACILITY is to be located and has an affirmative statement that the board of county commissioners or the county council does not oppose the issue of the permit.

(B) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION RELATING TO SLUDGE COMPOSTING FACILITIES DO NOT APPLY IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY. THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION RELATING TO SLUDGE COMPOSTING FACILITIES DO NOT APPLY TO SITES WITH PERMITS PENDING WITH THE DEPARTMENT BEFORE JUNE 1, 1979.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure—and—necessary for the immediate—preservation—of the public health and safety and having been passed by a yea and nay vote—supported by three-fifths—of—all the members—elected to each of the two Houses—of the General Assembly, the same—shall—take—effect from the date—of its passage shall take effect June 1, 1979.
