THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES SHALL CONTINUE TO DEVELOP AND MAINTAIN A PROGRAM TO CARRY OUT THE FURPOSES OF THIS SUBTITLE IN EACH OF THE LOCAL DEPARTMENTS OF SOCIAL SERVICES. IN IMPLEMENTING THIS PROGRAM THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES SHALL:

- (1) ADOPT REGULATIONS AND GUIDELINES FOR IMPLEMENTING THE PROGRAM IN EACH OF THE LOCAL DEPARTMENTS OF SOCIAL SERVICES:
- (2) CONTINUOUSLY MONITOR AND EVALUATE THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THIS PROGRAM;
- (3) MAINTAIN STAFF AT CURRENT LEVEL AND AS IN THE BUDGET;
- (4) PROVIDE FUNDS FOR THE TRAINING OF PERSONS NECESSARY TO PROVIDE ADEQUATE SERVICES; AND
- (5) (3) TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE, COORDINATE FOR FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN DELIVERY OF DAY CARE, HEALTH, EDUCATION, MENTAL HEALTH, EMPLOYMENT, HOUSING, AND CRISIS SERVICES PROVIDED BY PUBLIC AND PRIVATE AGENCIES.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.

(Senate Bill 177)

AN ACT concerning

Real Estate Brokers and Salesmen - Exceptions
