CHAPTER 438

(Senate Bill 310)

AN ACT concerning

State Colleges and Universities - Police Forces

FOR the purpose of specifying that each State university and college ~~has~~ may have a police force; defining the powers of the officers; requiring the Board of Trustees of State Universities and Colleges to adopt certain rules and regulations; excluding certain officers from certain rules and regulations; and repealing certain redundant provisions.
