SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

~~(A) THE COMMISSIONER OF HIGHER EDUCATION, ON BEHALF OF THE STATE BOARD FOR HIGHER EDUCATION, ACTING THROUGH THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, MAY PROCEED BY INJUNCTION OR OTHER APPROPRIATE JUDICIAL REMEDY IN AID OF THE AUTHORITY OF THE BOARD UNDER THIS TITLE.~~

~~(B) A PROCEEDING OR AN ORDER ISSUED IN OR AS A RESULT OF A PROCEEDING UNDER THIS SECTION DOES NOT BAR THE IMPOSITION OF ANY PENALTY THAT MAY BE IMPOSED FOR VIOLATION OF THIS TITLE.~~

(A) THE STATE BOARD FOR HIGHER EDUCATION MAY AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSIONER OF HIGHER EDUCATION, ACTING THROUGH THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, TO SEEK AN INJUNCTION OR OTHER JUDICIAL REMEDY FOR ANY VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF SUBTITLE 2 AND 3 OF TITLE 12 AND SUBTITLE 1 OF TITLE 17 OF THIS ARTICLE.

(B) THE REMEDIES PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION ARE IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER REMEDIES PROVIDED BY LAW.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.
