SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the passage of this Act is contingent upon the passage of 91r1028 SB 384 of 1979. Should that measure fail of enactment, the provisions of this Act are null and wold without the need of further action by the General Assembly.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1979.

CHAPTER 448

(Senate Bill 387)

AN ACT concerning

Motor Vehicles -- Hearings

FOR the purpose of permitting a person accused of unsafe driving by another person to require the Motor Vehicle Administration to summon the accuser; and requiring the accuser to testify under oath and be subject to cross examination; and requiring a notice of hearing to inform an accused person of certain rights.
