- [{6}] {7} If a licensee is a party to the hearing, the right of the Administration, on failure of the licensee to appear, to order a suspension of his license of privilege until he appears for a hearing.

- A-party-to-a hearing has the right to:
  - (1) Be represented by counsel;
  - (2) Cross-examine witnesses;
- {3} Inspect and copy all evidence to be introduced; [and ]
  - (4) Submit evidence; AND
- (5) HAVE THE ADMINISTRATION SUMMON ANY PERSON WHO ALLEGES THAT THE LICENSEE IS AN UNSAFE DRIVER AND REQUIRE THAT PERSON TO TESTIFY UNDER OATH.

## Suspension and Revocation of Driver's License
