FOR the purpose of changing the name of the Authority; providing for the creation and operation of additional markets in the Greater Baltimore Region; providing the Authority with powers to establish ancillary or other appurtenant facilities at markets; providing for an increase in the aggregate amount of the issuance of revenue bonds; allowing the Authority to determine the interest rate or rates at which revenue bonds may be issued; requiring the Authority to comply with certain provisions regarding purchases from minority businesses; and allowing the Authority to charge and apportion certain costs; and generally relating to operation of the Authority.
