bids[, and, if]. IF in its discretion the prices quoted are unreasonable, [it] THE COMMISSION may readvertise the work or any part of it, or may do any part or all of the work by day labor[; provided that]. AT any time the commission may, in its discretion, expend by day labor for construction work amount not exceeding \$15,000 without advertising or receiving bids. THE COMMISSION, BY RESOLUTION IMPLEMENTING REGULATIONS, MAY ESTABLISH A MANDATORY MINORITY BUSINESS UTILIZATION POLICY TO FACILITATE THE PARTICIPATION OF RESPONSIBLE MINORITY BUSINESS FIRMS IN CONTRACTS THE COMMISSION IN ACCORDANCE WITH COMPETITIVE BIDDING 2-YEAR PERIOD OF ANY THE PROCEDURES. AFTER THE COMMISSION SHALL ISSUE A REPORT CONCERNING ESTABLISHED. IMPLEMENTATION AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE TOGETHER WITH ANY APPROPRIATE RECOMMENDATIONS. PURPOSE OF THIS SUBSECTION, "MINORITY BUSINESS FIRM" MEANS A BUSINESS FIRM AT LEAST 50 PERCENT OF WHICH IS OWNED MINORITY GROUP MEMBERS, OR, IN THE CASE OF A PUBLICLY OWNED BUSINESS, AT LEAST 51 PERCENT OF THE STOCK OF WHICH IS OWNED MINORITY GROUP MEMBERS. "MINORITY GROUP MEMBERS" BLACKS HISPANIC ORIGIN), INCLUDES FEMALES, (NOT OF HISPANICS, AMERICAN INDIANS, ALASKAN NATIVES, ASIANS, PACIFIC ISLANDERS.

(B) All [such] contracts may be protected by [such] bonds, penalties, and conditions [as] REQUIRED BY the commission [shall require], all of which [shall be] ARE enforceable in any court having jurisdiction.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That if any provision of this Act, including any class provided for under subsection 3-2\{b\} (a), or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid for any reason in a court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or any other application of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and for this purpose the provisions of this Act are declared severable.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of June 30, 1981, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
