NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, IN BALTIMORE COUNTY THE FOLLOWING OFFICIALS SHALL BE TREATED AS LOCAL OFFICIALS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ANY FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE REQUIREMENTS ENACTED BY THE BALTIMORE COUNTY COUNCIL:

(I) EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AND MEMBERS OF THE REVENUE AUTHORITY;

(II) PRESIDENT AND MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF BALTIMORE COUNTY;

(III) SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS OF BALTIMORE COUNTY;

(IV) PAID AND UNPAID MEMBERS OF BOARDS OF ALL STATE AGENCIES FUNDED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY BALTIMORE COUNTY.

MEMBERS OF MARYLAND-NATIONAL CAPITAL PARK AND PLANNING COMMISSION, WASHINGTON SUBURBAN SANITARY COMMISSION AND WASHINGTON SUBURBAN TRANSIT COMMISSION.

(A) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE STATEMENT REQUIRED UNDER TITLE 3 SHALL, WHERE REFERENCING "BUSINESS WITH THE STATE" AND "EMPLOYED BY THE STATE," BE DEEMED TO MEAN "BUSINESS WITH THE STATE, COMMISSION, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, AND PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY" AND "EMPLOYED BY THE STATE, COMMISSION, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, AND PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY," RESPECTIVELY. THIS STATEMENT SHALL BE FILED UNDER OATH OR AFFIRMATION.

(B) EACH COMMISSIONER OF THE MARYLAND-NATIONAL CAPITAL PARK AND PLANNING COMMISSION, THE WASHINGTON SUBURBAN SANITARY COMMISSION, OR, IF APPOINTED FROM MONTGOMERY COUNTY OR PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, THE WASHINGTON SUBURBAN TRANSIT COMMISSION, SHALL FILE WITH THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER OF THE COUNTY FROM WHICH THE COMMISSIONER IS APPOINTED, ON OR BEFORE THE 15TH DAY OF APRIL OF EACH YEAR DURING THAT COMMISSIONER'S TERM IN OFFICE, THE STATEMENT SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (A) FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING EACH SUCH YEAR IN OFFICE.

(C) (1) EACH APPLICANT FOR APPOINTMENT AS COMMISSIONER OF THE MARYLAND-NATIONAL CAPITAL PARK AND PLANNING COMMISSION FROM MONTGOMERY COUNTY SHALL FILE WITH THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY COUNCIL AND THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY, NO LATER THAN FIVE DAYS PRIOR TO THE INITIAL DATE SET FOR INTERVIEW BY THE COUNCIL, THE STATEMENT SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (A), FOR THE 12-MONTH PERIOD ENDING 60 DAYS BEFORE THE DATE INITIALLY SET FOR THE
