(II) CAROLINE;

(III) DORCHESTER;

(III) (IV) TALBOT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.

(House Bill 59)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Registration Fees and Vehicle Weights
