Preamble

WHEREAS, Chapter 823 of the Acts of 1977 provided for an elected Board of Education for Somerset County, subject to the approval of the electorate in a referendum which was to be held on the subject in November, 1978.

When the laws relating to education were revised in the 1978 Session, it was decided to exclude the provisions of Chapter 823 of 1977 because of the referendum contingency. The voters of Somerset County approved the provisions of
