3-902.

AT ITS FIRST MEETING AT THE BEGINNING OF EACH YEAR, THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL ELECT A CHAIRMAN FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS. 3-903.

- (A) (1) ANNUAL COMPENSATION FOR THE BOARD IS AS FOLLOWS:
  - (I) CHAIRMAN \$2,000
  - (II) MEMBER \$1,800
- (2) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY PROVIDE ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION IN THE COUNTY BUDGET.
- (B) THE CHAIRMAN AND OTHER MEMBERS ARE ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES INCURRED IN OFFICIAL DUTIES PERFORMED OUTSIDE SOMERSET COUNTY.

3-904.

- (A) ALL FINAL ACTIONS OF THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL BE TAKEN AT A PUBLIC MEETING. THE BOARD SHALL KEEP A FORMAL RECORD OF EACH PUBLIC MEETING.
- (B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT THE BOARD FROM MEETING AND DELIBERATING IN EXECUTIVE SESSION PROVIDED THAT ALL ACTION IS TAKEN AT A PUBLIC MEETING.

Article 33 - Election Code

32-7A.

- (A) (1) A PERSON IS ELIGIBLE FOR CANDIDACY FOR ELECTION TO THE BOARD OF EDUCATION WHO:
- (I) OBTAINS THE SIGNATURES OF AT LEAST 200 REGISTERED VOTERS ON A PETITION THAT CONFORMS TO THE REQUIREMENTS FOR PETITIONS IN THIS ARTICLE, EXCEPT THAT PUBLICATION OF THE PETITION IS NOT REQUIRED;
- SUPERVISORS OF ELECTIONS BY 4:00-P=M= 9:00 P=M= ON THE MONDAY THAT IS 70 DAYS BEFORE THE DAY ON WHICH THE PRIMARY ELECTION IS HELD; AND

## (III) PAYS A \$25 FEE.

- (2) A PERSON MAY NOT DESIGNATE A PARTY AFFILIATION ON A PETITION REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION.
  - (3) A PERSON SEEKING AND DACY SHALL DESIGNATE
