

THE RIGHT TO A DE NOVO REVIEW OF THE REMOVAL BY THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR SOMERSET COUNTY.

3-902.

AT ITS FIRST MEETING AT THE BEGINNING OF EACH YEAR, THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL ELECT A CHAIRMAN FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS.

3-903.

(A) (1) ANNUAL COMPENSATION FOR THE BOARD IS AS FOLLOWS:

(I) CHAIRMAN - \$2,000

(II) MEMBER - \$1,800

(2) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY PROVIDE ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION IN THE COUNTY BUDGET.

(B) THE CHAIRMAN AND OTHER MEMBERS ARE ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES INCURRED IN OFFICIAL DUTIES PERFORMED OUTSIDE SOMERSET COUNTY.

3-904.

(A) ALL FINAL ACTIONS OF THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL BE TAKEN AT A PUBLIC MEETING. THE BOARD SHALL KEEP A FORMAL RECORD OF EACH PUBLIC MEETING.

(B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT THE BOARD FROM MEETING AND DELIBERATING IN EXECUTIVE SESSION PROVIDED THAT ALL ACTION IS TAKEN AT A PUBLIC MEETING.

Article 33 - Election Code

32-7A.

(A) (1) A PERSON IS ELIGIBLE FOR CANDIDACY FOR ELECTION TO THE BOARD OF EDUCATION WHO:

(I) OBTAINS THE SIGNATURES OF AT LEAST 200 REGISTERED VOTERS ON A PETITION THAT CONFORMS TO THE REQUIREMENTS FOR PETITIONS IN THIS ARTICLE, EXCEPT THAT PUBLICATION OF THE PETITION IS NOT REQUIRED;

(II) FILES THE PETITION WITH THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ELECTIONS BY ~~4:00 P.M.~~ 9:00 P.M. ON THE MONDAY THAT IS 70 DAYS BEFORE THE DAY ON WHICH THE PRIMARY ELECTION IS HELD; AND

(III) PAYS A \$25 FEE.

(2) A PERSON MAY NOT DESIGNATE A PARTY AFFILIATION ON A PETITION REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION.

(3) A PERSON SEEKING CANDIDACY SHALL DESIGNATE
