CHAPTER 569

(House Bill 619)

AN ACT concerning

Somerset County - Sale of Public Property

FOR the purpose of permitting in Somerset County the County Commissioners to sell certain public property under certain conditions without advertising the property for sale; and restructuring.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 25 - County Commissioners

Section 11A

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1973 Replacement Volume and 1978 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 25 - County Commissioners

11A.

(A) (1) The county commissioners of every county [in the State] may [acquire]:

(I) ACQUIRE by purchase, gift, devise, bequest, condemnation, or otherwise, any property, or any interest therein, of any kind needed for any public purpose, [and to erect]

(II) ERECT buildings thereon for the benefit of the county, and [to sell]

(III) SELL at public sale any property when no longer needed for public use[, but no property].
