- (2) PROPERTY may NOT be sold until it has been advertised for at least 20 days prior to the date of sale [provided, however, that in].
- (B) (1) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION PREVAIL OVER THOSE OF (A) TO THE EXTENT OF ANY INCONSISTENCY.
- (2) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES IN THE FOLLOWING COUNTIES:
 - (I) Frederick County[, the]
 - (II) SOMERSET COUNTY
- (3) THE County Commissioners may negotiate with any governmental body or agency located within the county for the sale of real property no longer needed by the county school board, without advertising the property for sale, after three independent appraisals have been obtained. Any proceedings for acquisition by condemnation shall be taken pursuant to Title 12 of the Real Property Article of the Code.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.
