

## Mosquito Control on State-Owned Land

FOR the purpose of requiring the use of State funds to pay for the expenses of mosquito control on State-owned land.

BY adding to

Article - Agriculture  
Section 5-404(e)  
Annotated Code of Maryland  
(1974 Volume and 1978 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Agriculture

5-404.

(E) ALL EXPENSES FOR MOSQUITO CONTROL ON STATE-OWNED LAND SHALL BE PAID FROM THE GENERAL FUNDS OF THE STATE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, ~~1979~~ 1980.

CHAPTER 600

(House Bill 1012)

AN ACT concerning

County Plans for Water, Sewerage, and Solid Waste

FOR the purpose of requiring that except in Montgomery County and Prince George's County plans by the Counties and Baltimore City for water, sewerage, and solid waste be submitted periodically, instead of annually, to the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 43 - Health  
Section 387C  
Annotated Code of Maryland  
(1971 Replacement Volume and 1978 Supplement)
