FOR the purpose of creating a Tidewater Administration within the Department of Natural Resources; removing the Coastal Zone Management Program from the Energy and Coastal Zone Administration and placing it within the Tidewater Administration; and generally relating to the Tidewater Administration.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article — Natural Resources Section 1-102(a) Annotated Code of Maryland (1974 Volume and 1978 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

 - (11) The Maryland State Board of Well Drillers
 - (12) The Scenic River Review Board
 - (13) The Upper Potomac River Commission
