CHAPTER 602

(House Bill 1069)

AN ACT concerning

Public School Employees - Assault Leave

FOR the purpose of providing that an employee of a county board of education receives paid leave time for an assault occurring within the scope of employment; establishing certain rules for the use of assault leave; and generally relating to assault leave for public school employees.
