OR SUBSCRIPTION OR OCCUPANCY AGREEMENT, OF THE CONSUMER COOPERATIVE, A COPY OF THESE DOCUMENTS SHALL BE PROVIDED TO ANY INDIVIDUAL WISHING TO PURCHASE A MEMBERSHIP CERTIFICATE PRIOR TO THE ACTUAL PURCHASE.

THE CHARTER OR BYLAWS OF A CONSUMER COOPERATIVE SHALL CONTAIN A STATEMENT OF THE RIGHTS OF A MEMBER IF THE MEMBERSHIP IS TERMINATED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION. A MEMBER WHOSE MEMBERSHIP IS TERMINATED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE NOT LESS THAN THE AMOUNT PAID FOR THE MEMBERSHIP.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1979.

CHAPTER 612

(House Bill 1155)

AN ACT concerning

Fire Fighters - Autopsies

FOR the purpose of requiring a certain procedure to be performed on certain firemen fire fighters who die in the line of duty.

BY adding to

Article 22 - Postmortem Examiners Section 7(c) Annotated Code of Maryland (1973 Replacement Volume and 1978 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 22 - Postmortem Examiners

7.

AN AUTOPSY OF A PIREMAN FIRE FIGHTER WHO DIES IN THE LINE OF DUTY, OTHER THAN BY A PHYSICAL INJURY, SHALL INCLUDE A TOXICOLOGICAL ANALYSIS FOR TOXIC FUMES. ANALYSIS SHALL BE SUFFICIENT FOR DETERMINING ELIGIBILITY FOR BENEFITS UNDER COMPLY WITH THE PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS BENEFITS ACT OF 1976.
