THE FIRE CHIEF, HIS TWO CHIEF DEPUTIES OR HIS DESIGNATED FIRST AND SECOND CHIEF ASSISTANTS FIRE POLICE OF EACH VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY IN KENT COUNTY MAY HAVE THEIR VEHICLES EQUIPPED WITH RED OR WHITE, OR RED AND WHITE AMBER LIGHTS OR SIGNAL DEVICES DESIGNED TO EMIT AN OSCILLATING, ROTATING, BLINKING, OR OTHER TYPE OF EMISSION OF LIGHT. THE LIGHTS OR SIGNAL DEVICES MAY BE FLASHED OR OSCILLATED OR OTHERWISE USED ONLY WHILE ON ROUTE TO OR AT THE SCENE OF AN ACCIDENT, FLOOD, OR OTHER EMERGENCY TO WHICH THE VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY IS RESPONDING.

THE FIRE CHIEF, HIS TWO CHIEF DEPUTIES OR HIS DESIGNATED FIRST AND SECOND CHIEF ASSISTANTS OF EACH VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY IN QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY MAY HAVE THEIR VEHICLES EQUIPPED WITH RED OR WHITE, OR RED AND WHITE LIGHTS OR SIGNAL DEVICES DESIGNED TO ENIT AN OSCILLATING, ROTATING, BLINKING, OR OTHER TYPE OF EMISSION OF LIGHT. THE LIGHTS OR SIGNAL DEVICES MAY BE FLASHED OR OSCILLATED OR OTHERWISE USED ONLY WHILE ON ROUTE TO OR AT THE SCENE OF AN ACCIDENT, FLOOD, OR OTHER EMERGENCY TO WHICH THE VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY IS RESPONDING.

(b) (1) The provisions of this subtitle are applicable in Carroll County, Cecil County, [and] Frederick County, AND KENT COUNTY, respectively, except as modified [herein] IN THIS SECTION. THE SHERIFF OF KENT COUNTY SHALL APPOINT NOT MORE THAN THREE MEMBERS OF ANY VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY IN KENT COUNTY AS DEPUTIES TO FUNCTION AS FIRE POLICE. The sheriff of [the county] CARROLL COUNTY, CECIL COUNTY, AND FREDERICK COUNTY shall appoint not more than six members of any fire company as deputies to function as fire police. The powers of [such] THE deputies are limited to those necessary to perform their duties when functioning as fire police at parades, accidents, floods, or other emergencies, or at any public function conducted by, or under the auspices of, any volunteer fire company.
