The [said] clerk, before he enters upon the duties of his office, shall give bond to the State of Maryland, to be approved by the County Commissioners, in the penalty of [one thousand dollars] \$1,000, conditioned for the faithful performance of the duties of his office.[,and the said] THE bond shall be recorded in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Calvert County.

The [said] clerk shall [also] take and subscribe before one of [said] THE Commissioners the following oath: "I, A.B., do swear that as Clerk to the County Commissioners for Calvert County, I will honestly and faithfully, to the best of my skill and judgment, execute the duties of the [said] office, without favor, affection or prejudice."

122.

[He is authorized and empowered to] THE CLERK MAY administer an oath or affirmation to any person presenting a claim to [said] THE Commissioners against the county[, for which service he]. HE [shall] MAY not [be entitled to] make any charge[, the same being hereby made] FOR THIS SERVICE SINCE IT IS a part of his official duty.

The County Commissioners of Calvert County [are hereby authorized and empowered to] MAY sell [such] WHATEVER part of its water supply IT DOES not [needed] NEED for county purposes to some person, firm or corporation on [such] terms and conditions [as said] TO BE DETERMINED BY THE Commissioners [shall determine].
