THE treasurer shall pay over according to law or (e) order of the County Commissioners [, in the manner the hereinbefore prescribed, all county taxes and all moneys due [said] THE county and collected by him. [; and he] HE shall [also] pay over ALSO to the Treasurer of the State [of Maryland] according to law[,] all the State taxes levied [said] THE county and collected by him, and he shall be allowed until [the thirty-first day of] December 31 of next succeeding the levy to complete [the] collection [thereof,] and to make his final settlement with [said] County Commissioners and with the Treasurer of Maryland, respectively. [; and he] HE shall have [said] THAT time to complete his collections and make his final settlement whether his term of office has expired [; and all] ALL claims for erroneous, insolvent or uncollectible tax bills for which he [shall claim] CLAIMS credit shall be presented before or at the time specified for [said] THE final settlement, and in no case shall [said] Commissioners allow credit [therefor] FOR THEM after the term specified for final settlement. [, and at] AT the expiration of the time for final settlement his bond or bonds shall be liable for the unaccounted balance [it shall be the duty of] the County hands, and Commissioners [and they are hereby required to] SHALL enter suit upon the county bond of [said] THE treasurer for all county taxes remaining uncollected.

At the general election held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November every fourth year, accounting from the year 1942, [there shall be elected] a county treasurer for Calvert County SHALL BE ELECTED by the qualified voters of [said] THE county[,] who shall hold office for four years[, and] OR until his successor is elected and qualified. [, as is hereinafter provided, to] HE [be] IS subject to removal for wilful neglect of duty or misdemeanor in office upon conviction in a court of law. [; he] HE [shall] IS not [be] eligible [to] FOR re-election until after an interval of one full term and until he [shall have] HAS fully settled up all business connected with his former term. [; and the] THE persons elected to [said] THIS office under the provisions of this section shall hold [the same] IT for four years from [the first day of] January 1 succeeding their election. [; and the said] THE treasurer shall [in all respects] be clothed IN ALL RESPECTS with the powers given by this subtitle.
